People pay for results.

Task-Based Language

- ❌ "I manage social media."
- ❌ "I create content."
- ❌ "I answer customer enquiries."
- ❌ "I run workshops."
- ❌ "I do graphic design."

Value-Based Language

- ✅ "I help businesses attract more clients through strategic social media."
- ✅ "I create content that builds trust and increases visibility."
- ✅ "I improve customer experience and client retention."
- ✅ "I help people gain clarity and take action."
- ✅ "I create visual identities that help brands stand out."
